Class 13: One Frame Exhibit

Exhibits in this class should be based on a narrow subject that is best treated as One frame. An extract from a past International award-winning multiple frame exhibits (5 to 8 frames) to One Frame is not allowed.

Awards are presented by Points (60 points to 100 points) and awarded by certificates only. Souvenir medal of BANGABANDHU 2021 will be given to all participants awarded 60 points or above. Certificate of Participation will be given to exhibits attaining less than 60 points. Please indicate clearly in the Exhibit Application Form above which class exhibit applying for the One Frame exhibit.

Class 14: Philatelic Literature

- k. Philatelic books and research papers (published on or after January 1, 2016)
- l. Philatelic magazines and periodicals (the whole annual volume issued after January 1, 2016)
- m. Catalogues (published after January 1, 2016)

Article 6 – JUDGING OF EXHIBITS AND AWARDS

- Exhibits in the Competitive Classes will be judged by the appointed accredited FIP judges as well as accredited Continental Federation judges and National Federation judges in accordance with the principles laid down in the GREV and SREVs.
- The scan copy of Expertized Certificate must be sent via email to Commissioner General if previously asked in any International or World exhibition. A small letter © is to be denoted at the right bottom corner of the display sheet.
- The Jury shall penalize exhibits containing forgeries or reproductions not so described. The jury reserved the right to seek confirmation of ownership of material or the whole exhibit.

Article 7 – FRAME SIZE AND ALLOTMENT OF FRAMES

The virtual exhibition frame at BANGABANDHU 2021 shall have a capacity of all FIP recommended allowable exhibit sheet sizes.

- (21 x 29.7) cm or (23 x 29) cm – 4 sheets in one row, **total 16 sheets in a frame**
- (42 x 29.7) cm or (46 x 29) cm – 2 sheets in one row, **total 8 sheets in a frame**
- (31 x 29) cm – 3 sheets in one row, **total 12 sheets in a frame**
- Also, can mix match with Single & Double size page in same frame as like physical exhibition.
- All exhibits must be mounted or prepared on white or light-colored sheets. No exhibit mounted on dark colored or black background sheets will be accepted.
- Every exhibit shall be allowed 5 or 8 frames (except for the classes 12, 13 and 14) according to GREX Articles 6.3 and 6.4.

Class 12: Youth Philately

- h. 1 – 3 frames
- i. 2 – 4 frames
- j. 3 – 5 frames

Class 13: One-Frame Exhibits 1 frame

Article 8 – APPLICATIONS AND ACCEPTANCE

- Exhibitors shall submit one Exhibit Application Form for each exhibit via online through exhibition website www.bangabandhu2021.com

- National Commissioners will notify as soon any application submit from his/her country via online. Commissioners can preliminarily accept or reject any application in consult with their National Federation and process to the organizing committee through online platform.
- The Organizing Committee shall have the final authority to accept or reject the application without specifying the reason.
- Exhibit online Application form duly filled shall be submitted, together with a copy of the introductory page, in English languages, by October 1, 2021.
- Exhibitors may enter exhibits under a pseudonym. However, their true identities must be notified to the Organizing Committee (GREX Article 16).
- Notification of acceptance or rejection shall be sent to the respective Commissioner & exhibitors no later than by October 10, 2021.
- The National Commissioners shall collect the participation fees from the exhibitors or advise exhibitors to remit them to the Organizing Committee directly by October 30, 2021.
- Each exhibit shall be listed in the exhibition catalogue under its given title as stated in the application form.
- When the title of the exhibit differs from the original title (irrespective of minor or major changes), the previous title of the exhibit must be also stated in exhibit application form. Furthermore, the exhibitor's identity number created by FIP must be stated. This ID number can be obtained from the secretary of the respective Federation.

Article 9 – PARTICIPATION FEE

- There is no fee for Non-Competitive Class entries.
- The participation fee for Competitive Classes (except Classes 12, 13 and 14) is \$25 per frame.
- The participation fee for Youth Philately Class (Class 10) \$10 per frame
- The participation fee for One Frame Exhibit (Class 11) is \$ 40
- The participation fee for Philatelic Literature (Class 12) is \$25 per exhibit.

Article 10 – SUBMISSION OF EXHIBITS

- Exhibit scans copy as JPG format page by page can be emailed to the Commissioner General, sent via cloud storage link such as dropbox or uploaded on the special file uploader on the exhibition website <https://www.bangabandhu2021.com> via EXHIBIT UPLOAD menu button by November 15, 2021 by commissioners or directly by exhibitors.
- Commissioner's will notify submission of exhibits update by November 20, 2021, for his/her country. Commissioner's can advise or request to the organizing committee for any image upload or change or data correction on behalf of the exhibitors by 30th November 2021.
- Scans should be at least 300 dpi, (Height 1750 px. Width by default ratio) (Maximum per page 2 MB) and each page consecutively numbered (via the file name) as follows:

Mix match sheet size possible only with single & double sheet size. As like physical, in a row, maximum 4 sheets capacity. So, each row can combination of maximum (4 of single sheet) or maximum (2 of double sheet) or maximum (2 of single sheet & 1 of double sheet) possible. Not any other combination allowed. Sheet size double not possible to place in the last position of each row. For combination mix match frame as followed:

p9	p10	p11	p12
p13	p14	p15	

Row 1 = 2 of single (p1, p4) & 1 of double (p2)

Row 2 = 2 of double (p5, p7)

Row 3 = 4 of single (p9, p10, p11, p12)

Row 4 = 2 of single (p13, p14) & 1 of double (p15)

- Exhibitors in the Philatelic Literature Class (Class 14) must send two copies of each title no later than by November 15, 2021, in order that preliminary judging may take place. These copies are not returnable. Periodicals may be exhibited as a complete volume only.
- The address to which the exhibits must be sent shall be informed by the Organizing Committee in due course.

Article 11 – ACCEPTANCE OF THESE REGULATIONS

- By submitting the Exhibit Application Form, the exhibitor shall be deemed to accept the stipulations of the IREX, GREX, GREV and SREVs.

Article 12 – RIGHTS OF ORGANIZING COMMITTEE

- Every exhibitor applying to exhibit at BANGABANDHU 2021 is deemed to have accepted the stipulations of the IREX.
- The Organizing Committee shall have the right to revise the IREX if necessary. Exhibitors shall be promptly notified of any of such revisions either directly or through his Commissioner.
- The Organizing Committee shall have the right to adjudicate any problems arising that are not covered by FIP Regulations or by the IREX, and its decisions shall be final.
